NATHAN OSTHEIMER, M.D.

DR. NATHAN OSTHEIMER SEES PATIENTS IN OUR WAYNESBORO OFFICE, OF VALLEY PEDIATRICS, A RURAL UNDERSERVED AREA OF VIRGINIA. HE IS A NATIVE OF THE RICHMOND AREA AND GRADUATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA SCHOOL OF MEDICINE. HE COMPLETED HIS RESIDENCY IN PEDIATRICS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF UTAH SCHOOL OF MEDICINE'S PRIMARY CHILDREN'S MEDICAL CENTER. DR. OSTHEIMER HAS BEEN A PRACTICING PEDIATRICIAN FOR OVER 10 YEARS.

MELODY AILSWORTH, D.O.

DR. AILSWORTH GREW UP IN LOUISIANA AND GRADUATED FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL FLORIDA WITH A DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY.
